Return visit information



**Before returning to the
Outpatient Bronchiolitis Clinic**

- Attempt to suction your baby’s nose with a bulb or nasal aspirator and saline drops.
- If, after suctioning at home, your baby is still having difficulty breathing, eating or sleeping, then bring your child to the suction clinic.

If you need to return to the clinic

- When you arrive, please enter at the Emergency Department entrance.
- Stop at the desk and let the nurse know you are here for the Bronchiolitis Clinic. The nurse will evaluate your child and check his/her oxygen level, before directing you to admissions.
- Admissions staff will verify your information and then notify the respiratory therapist that you are waiting.
- **Please do not feed your child while waiting for the respiratory therapist.**
- Please wait until the respiratory therapist can meet you and take you to the exam room to suction your baby.
- Wait times for the clinic depend on hospital emergencies and how many patients are waiting.

Precaution
